FAO MONEY AND MEDALS : Newsletter 23

Dear Friend,

We are pleased to announce FAO Money Album 7 (pages 28-33) and FAO Money Panels 10-12, both collections with the identical 48 coins. The price for the six-page album will be \$120, with the same price for the three panels.

The 16 coins to go in FAO Money Panel 10 and the first two pages of Album 7 will be:

Egypt 5, 10 milliemes, 10 piastres, 1 roud (silver) 1977	Saudi Arabia 1 riyal
Guiné-Bissau 50 centavos: 1, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ , 5, 20 pesos	Seychelles 5, 10 rupees

The 16 coins to go in FAO Money Panel 11 and in the second two pages of Album 7 will be:

The 16 coins to go in FAO Money Panel 12 and in the third two pages of Album 7 will probably be:

Bangladesh 10, 50 poisha	Lebanon 5 pounds	Pakistan 25, 50 paise
Egypt 10 milliemes, 5 piastres, 1 roud (silver) 1978	Maldives 5, 25 rupees (silver)	Sudan 1 roud
India 10, 50 rupees (silver) 1978	Nepal 20 paise	Yemen (Sana'a) 1 fils, 1 rial

2. We shall try to ship out Album 7 and Panels 10-12 by December, either in whole or in part. Some of the above coins, especially those listed for Panel 12, may be replaced by others put into circulation earlier. This happened with the Saudi 1 riyal listed above for Panel 10, whose planned place in Panel 9 (and Album 6 page 26) was taken by the 1977 5 piastre coin of Egypt.

Self-financing enterprise within FAO

3. In Newsletter 22 of 22 August 1977 we reported on the financial side of the FAO Money and Medals Programme to 31 December 1976. Twelve months later, cumulative sales had risen to \$9,236,000. Personnel costs over the ten-year period 1968-1977 were \$1,098,000, a proportion which has remained at 12%. However, it will be recalled that these are the costs not only of a \$9.2 million sales operation, but of an information programme of getting some 4,000,000,000 FAO coins, with an exchange value of some \$120,000,000, put into circulation in over 90 countries. The net profit for the ten-year period rose to \$1,765,000, of which \$442,000 was invested in inventory. Of the remaining \$1,323,000, some \$883,000 has been spent or allocated to 27 projects promoting rural women's advancement, farm credit, small farmers organizations, and group feeding. A list of these 27 projects is given overleaf.
